Current status and next steps

- It is our duty to develop skateboarding as a popular sport as expected by Swiss Olympic
- As skateboarding is not as organised as other associations we have asked for support from SO
- Roadmap for development is layed out and enfolds as follows:
 - Q1 2026 define and assign project team -> Cedi Romanans, Claudia Riera, Matthew Lee
 - Q2-Q3 2026 first draft of skateboard training concept and create expert group
 - > expert group consisting of exisiting experts in all 4 language areas (10-15 members)
 - Q4 2026 first workshop with expert group to refine training concept
 - > workshop to take place at FSA Laax (NASAK) end of November 26
 - Q1-Q2 2027 finalise concept, approval by board and integration into popular sports concept
 - Q3-Q4 2027 first pilot courses and evaluation by expert group
 - Q3 2027 re-admission of J&S application (or sooner if possible)
 - Q1-Q2 2028 start and promote regular courses in regional centers
 - Q3-Q4 2028 evaluation and first update of training concept

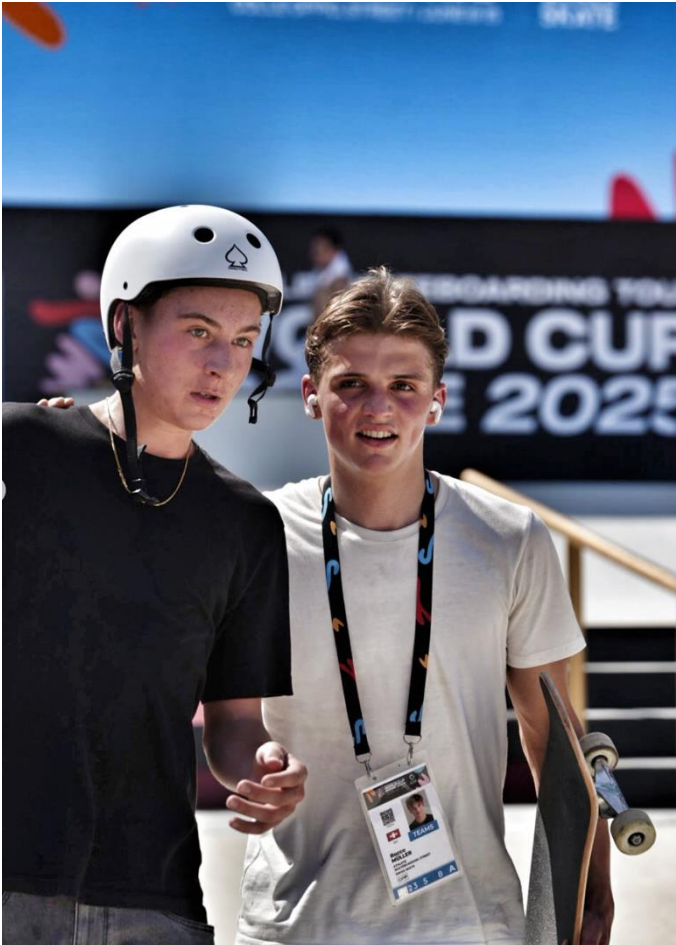

- Slot will be awarded after WST Rome, depending on results

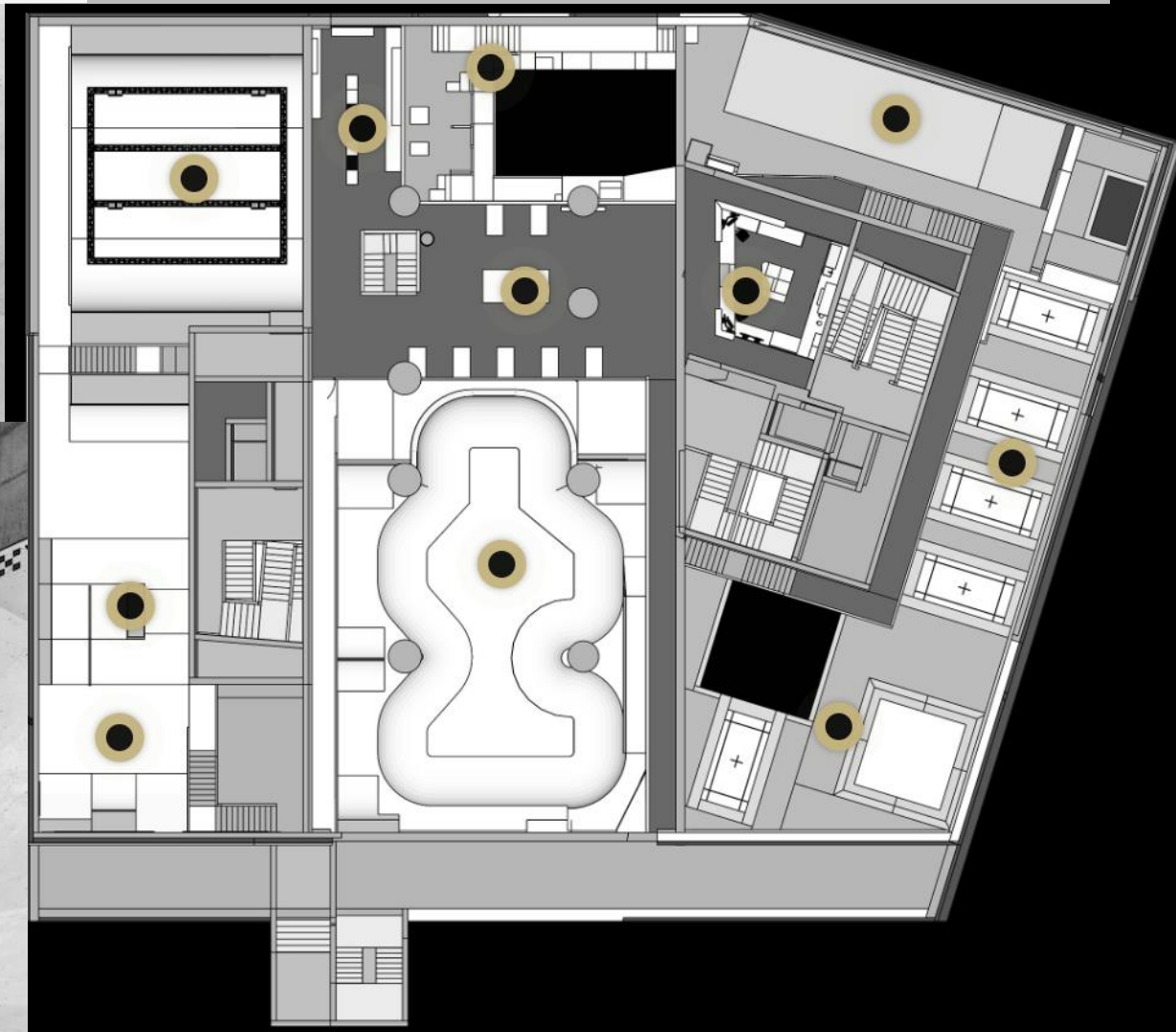


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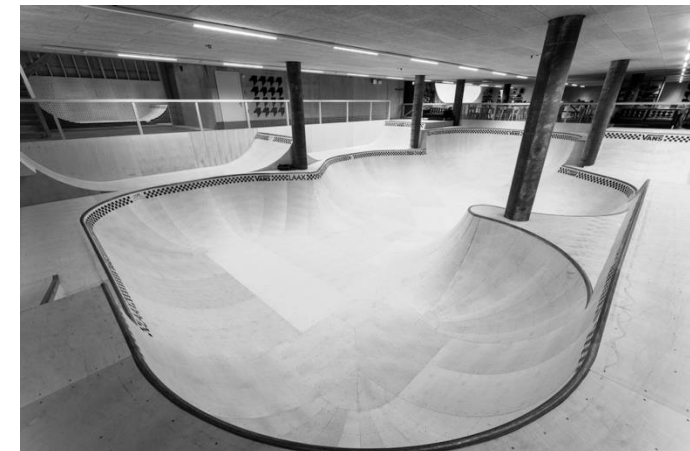

NASAK: Freestyle Academy Laax

- Freestyle Academy Laax was added to the NASAK catalogue at the end of 2025 as a sports infrastructure of national importance for skateboarding.
- Since this year, we have been able to finance NASAK contributions for training sessions and competitions held in Laax by Swiss Olympic Card Holders.
- This includes not only entry fees but also accommodation and third-party services.

Die Prüfung beschränkt sich auf die Überprüfung der sachgemässen Buchführung des Vereins im Rahmen einer Laienrevision sowie auf die zweckgebundene Verwendung der öffentlichen Mittel. Hierbei wurde der Prozess der Erstellung der Jahresrechnung kritisch hinterfragt sowie die Transaktionen von wesentlichen Positionen stichprobenartig überprüft.

Prüfungsurteil

Bei meiner Revision bin ich auf keinerlei wesentliche Sachverhalte gestossen, aus denen wir schliessen müssten, dass die Jahresrechnung ein nicht den tatsächlichen Verhältnissen entsprechendes Bild der Vermögens-, Finanz- und Ertragslage vermittelt und dem Gesetz und den Statuten entspricht.
