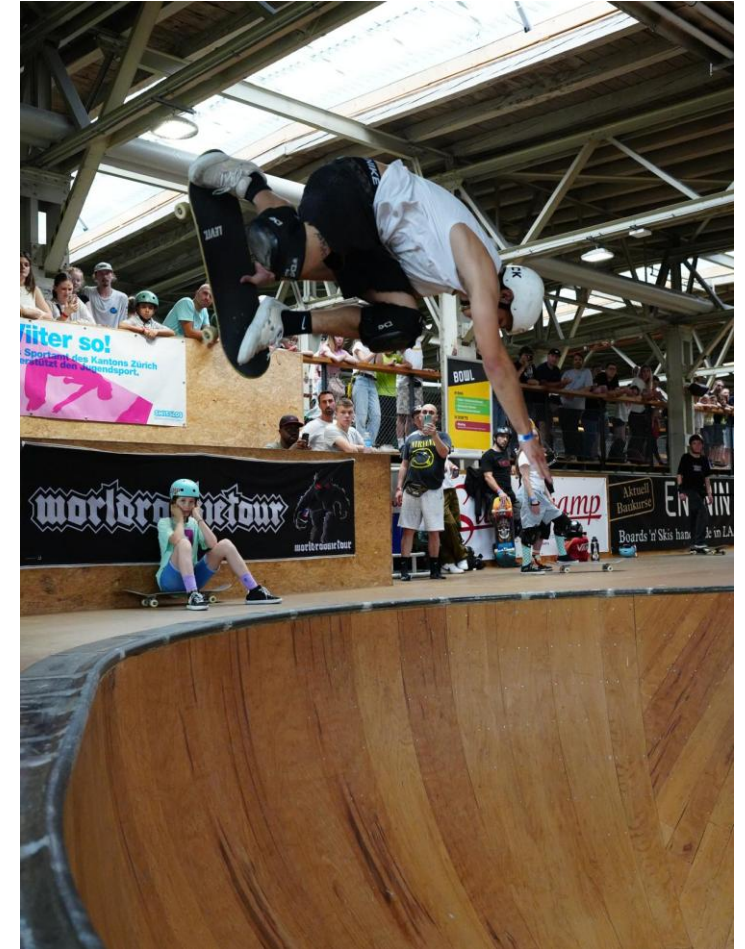

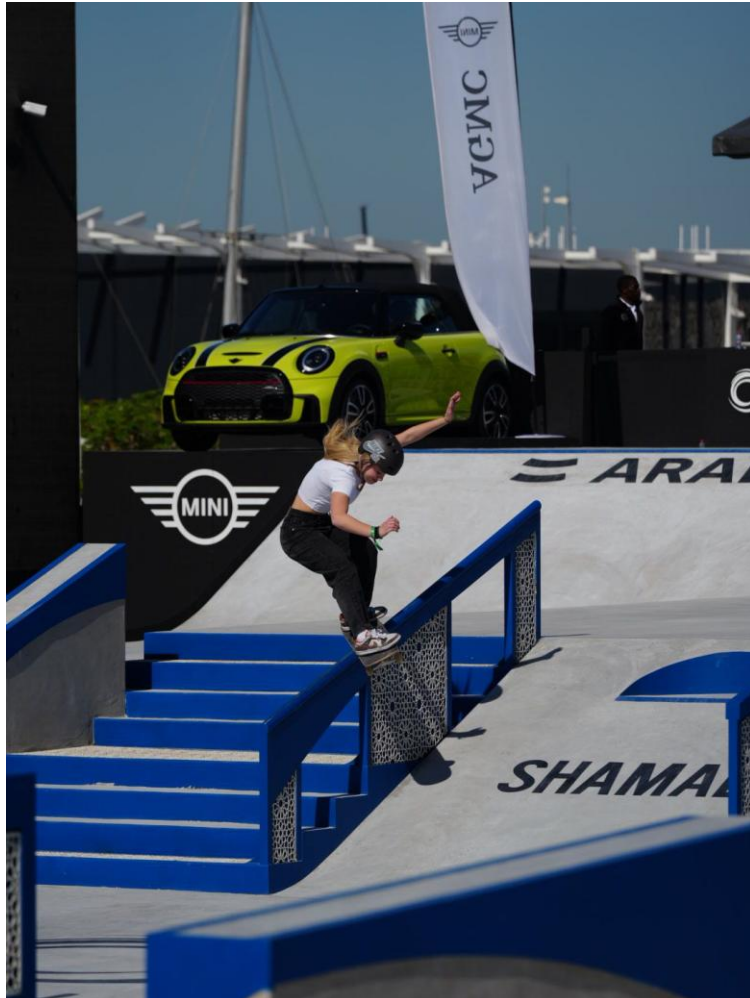
## 2026

- Application completed and sent to BASPO September 13 2024
- Revised application accepted and all criterias met by end of 2024 with positive feedback given
- Suspension of all new applications communicated March 27 2025  
20% Budget cuts to all J&S Sports

## Next steps:

- resending application as soon as suspension is lifted
- Consider building coaching structure independantly
- Connect with Swiss Olympic for help and support the effort to revoke budget cuts

## Bund kürzt Subventionen für Jugend+Sport um 20 Prozent

- Der Bund kürzt seine Subventionen für Jugend+Sport – kurz J+S – ab kommendem Jahr um 20 Prozent.
- Als Grund wird der wachsende Zulauf angegeben bei gleichzeitigen Sparvorgaben des Bundesrates.
- Über 680'000 Kinder und Jugendliche nehmen jährlich an Jugend+Sport-Kursen und -Lagern teil, in über 85 Sportarten.

Die Rekordzahlen und die Prognosen führten dazu, dass bei gleichbleibendem Kredit die Beiträge ab 2026 um 20 Prozent gekürzt werden müssten, hiess es in einer Mitteilung des Bundesamtes für Sport (Baspo). Partner wie Sportverbände und Kantone seien über die jüngsten Entwicklungen und die Prognosen informiert.

## Prüfungsumfang

Die Prüfung beschränkt sich auf die Überprüfung der sachgemässen Buchführung des Vereins im Rahmen einer Laienrevision sowie auf die zweckgebundene Verwendung der öffentlichen Mittel. Hierbei wurde der Prozess der Erstellung der Jahresrechnung kritisch hinterfragt sowie die Transaktionen von wesentlichen Positionen stichprobenartig überprüft.

## Prüfungsurteil
